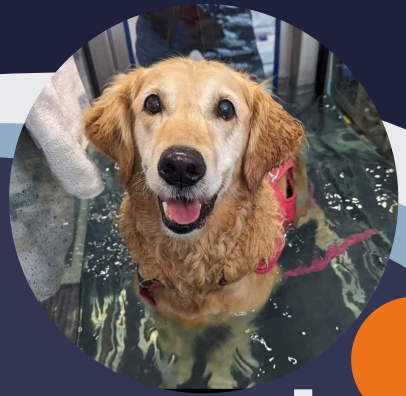

**Course provision can be tailored, bespoke to each individual learner based on previous experience, location and learning preferences, however there will be mandatory, in-person practical days at one of our centres.**

Each module is mandatory, with no optional units. Each will include a variety of informal and formal assessment, as well as production of one overall portfolio.

A combination of independent learning, live online learning and face-to-face sessions will be utilised.

All practical elements will be carried out at Operation K9 Hydrotherapy Centre.



# Application and Enrolment

There are no formal entry requirements for this course, however we will hold an informal interview, and do recommend students obtain work experience in a hydrotherapy centre or similar environment if they are new to the industry.

If students have no animal handling experience, particularly with canines, we will require they obtain this elsewhere prior to enrolment onto the course, or they can book a taster day in one of our centres.

On successful application, you will be enrolled onto the course, given a log-in to our online learning platform and invited to an enrolment event. There are multiple enrolment opportunities throughout the year.





# Fees and Payment Options

The course cost is £3800, which includes your 8 practical training days at one of our centres as well as access to live, interactive sessions, online content and materials, face-to-face sessions, and 1:1 support and guidance.

Payment plans including monthly payment options up to 18months, or in 6 instalments. .

Prior learning will be taken into account. For RVN's and Vet Physio's, some modules are not required to complete the qualification, therefore discount can be applied.
